Layered Landscapes Workshop January 9, 2021, 9 am- noon

Create a simple, fun, free-form Layered Landscape, choosing either the Marsh Scene or the Harvest Scene or create something of your own. Instructions and appliques will be mailed out to those who register for the class. **Please register by December 21, 2020.**

Supplies:

1. Both Scenes

- Batting 10 x 12";
- Backing fabric 10 x 12";
- Blue sky fabric 8 x 10";
- Sewing machine, extension cord, walking foot (optional, but very useful), thread to match each fabric, pins, glue stick, cutting board and rotary cutter, and iron and small ironing board.

2. Choose the Marsh Scene

- Cotton, gauze, and/or burlap fabric of 7-8 different turquoise strips, each 8 x 4";
- A picture frame with an approximately 8 x 10 matted opening,
- Contrasting border, 4 strips 13" x 2" (Optional—not needed if you use a picture frame.)
- Binding 2 1/2" wide (Optional—not needed if you use a frame.)

3. OR Choose the Harvest Scene

- Cotton fabric of 7-8 different orange and green strips, each 8 x 4";
- 4 solid orange strips, each 13 x 1" for small inner border
- 4 light green strips, each 15x 3" for outer border;
- Binding should be a continual strip to fit outside border, 74" X 2 1/2 " wide.

Experience Needed—Working knowledge of your sewing machine, how to pin top piece, batting, and backing together and machine quilt the sandwich, and how to put on a binding. If you are unfamiliar with these techniques, please search Google and watch one or two YouTube videos about it before the class.
