

**Stained Glass Workshop
Phyllis Cullen**

**Nov. 5, 2021, 3-6 pm, continuing Nov. 6, 10 am-1 pm

Phyllis Cullen has taught this class on stained glass quilts all over the world, in person, and via Zoom. Everyone finds it easy and fun! She loves bright happy colors, and to teach. She is available anytime via email to help her students. It's all about the color! She currently lives and works on the beautiful Hamakua coast of Hawaii's Big Island. She is the Hawaiian region rep for SAQA (Studio Art Quilters Associates), an international textile arts organization.

For this workshop, you may use any stained-glass pattern, one of Phyllis', or create your own. You will then make a raw-edge fusible, appliquéd, and quilted piece that not only looks like real stained glass but requires no fussy edge treatments, no bias tape, no fussy quilting. It is quick, easy, and fun!

Then we add some optional oil stick painting, and optional applique, or optional embellishment, and quilt either with free motion or walking foot. This class is appropriate for beginners, who will learn basic free-motion quilting as well. A full handout and supply list will be emailed to registered participants well in advance, as well as the pattern of their choice from my website gallery. Kits are available. Full size patterns are available. The class recording is also available to students for 2 months.

There are 2 parts to this workshop, on Friday and on Saturday. The patterns, kits and Zoom link will be sent to you prior to the workshop. Costs are explained on the Registration form.
